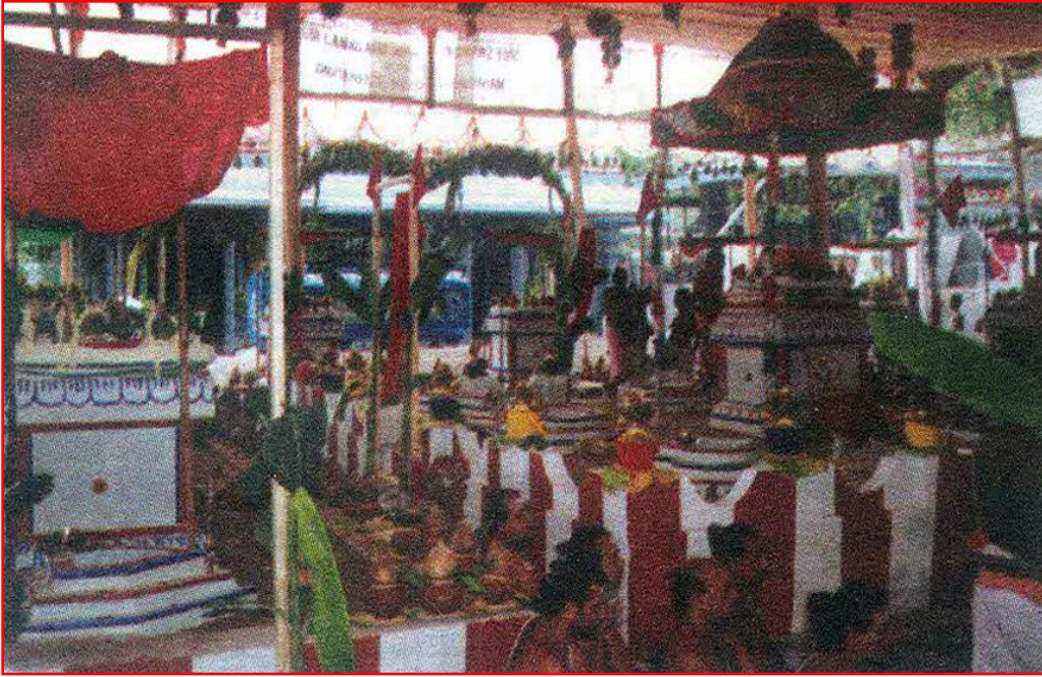


Ati Rudram and Navchandi Homam
