With the divine grace of Lord Swaminatha, holy blessings of Sree Kanchi Kamakoti Peetadhipathi Jagadguru Sri Sankaracharya Swamigal and abundant goodwill and support of devotee public of Delhi, entire Bharat and countries abroad, the Board of Management of the Samaj is pleased to inform that the much awaited Maha Kumbhabhishekam of the newly built exquisite Raja Gopuram, gold plated fresh kalasams over the Vimanams of Lord Vinayakar, Lord Sundareswarar, Devi Meenakshi, Sree Idumban Swami and Sri Aadi Sankara Mandapam, Ashta Bhandanam adorned Garbha Graha Moorthis and other Deities, will be performed on the auspicious Wednesday, the 2nd July, 2014 between 9.00 a.m. and 10.00 am. Elaborate arrangements are being made in a befitting manner to celebrate this event.

17 Homa (Havan) Kundas, to be manned by 30 Veda-Aagama learned scholars (Sivacharyas), drawn from various great temples in Tamil Nadu, will be established for performance of Yagams. An exquisite VEDIKAI will be constructed in the middle of Yaga Sala to hold the sacred main Ghatam (Holy Pot) to represent Lord Swaminatha Swami, around which nine Havan Kundas in different shapes will be erected for performance of Maha Yagam. The other eight yaga kundas will be built at different places within the yaga sala. The whole yaga sala will be transformed as a temple and during the six kala yagnas and elaborate Poojas, the entire Sakthi of the main Deities, drawn into the Ghatams containing mixed water of seven Holy rivers, would be sanctified, rejuvenated and made ready for retransfer into the main Deities by performance of Kumbhabhishekam and Mahabhishekam. The very sight of the entire function with six Kala Poojas for four days would be divine, thrilling and purifying.

It is estimated that the entire cost of this holy event would be around Rs.1.25 crore. The various items of worship for which devotees can contribute and participate are listed separately. All are requested to extend their benevolent hands for the successful conduct of the function, which occurs only once in twelve years.
