संहति पाठमात्रेण यत्फलं प्रोच्यते बुधैः पदेतु दवगुणं प्रोक्तं क्रमेतु च चतुरगुणम् ॥
वर्णक्रमे शतगुणं जटायां तु सहस्रकम् | घनस्य पाठमात्रेण ह्यनन्तफलश्रुते ॥

That which is attained by chanting normally, twice that is attained by Pada (word), four times with Krama, Varnakrama yields 100-fold benefits, Jata yields 1000 fold results. However, the infinite is obtained from Ghana Parayanam.

The word "संहति" is derived from the verbal root "samh" (सम्ह), which means "to collect," "to join together," or "to put together." The addition of the suffix "-ता" denotes a collection or compilation of things related to the root. The term "Samhita" refers to a collection or compilation of mantras and hymns. These texts are considered to be the oldest and most authoritative scriptures.

Chanting Samhitas holds significant spiritual and ritualistic importance for several reasons:

- Establishes a direct connection with the divine forces and energies by invoking the presence of deities and cosmic energies.
- Helps individuals focus their minds, maintain a sense of devotion, and align themselves with higher spiritual principles
- Purifies the mind, body, and soul
- Preserves ancient Vedic traditions and knowledge.
- Attracts divine blessings and protection
- Serves as a form of meditation and mindfulness practice

It's important to note that chanting Samhitas is traditionally performed with proper pronunciation and understanding of the meanings behind the mantras. It is often passed down through a guru-disciple lineage to ensure the integrity of the chanting. Additionally, chanting Samhitas can be done individually or as part of group rituals and ceremonies.

A grand Veda Parayanam (Yajurveda Samhita) is to be held at Malai Mandir on 19th August, 2023 (Saturday) as details below. A well known Scholar & Head of Kalady Veda Patashala Sri RAMESH DRAVID will be conducting this programme with all his disciples. It's a rare opportunity for our Delhites to listen to it.
